Presented in a format that proved so effective with Foreshore Publications' earlier titles Workboat Code of Practice - An Operator's Guide and ISPS Code – A Practical Guide (and the later 2004 Update) the new title retains the easy-to-reference margin text locators that offer thumbnail indications of the more detailed official text displayed adjacently.

Of particular importance is the full Keyword Index that cross-references all the official texts contained within the publication.

The inclusion of Checklists and Overviews of key elements of port waste management provides further clarification.

Sample Certificate layouts and Forms are also included for most certification and official notification purposes.
